



Maryland Medicaid Update

We are writing to inform you of important changes to Maryland Medicaid that will impact the way Gladstone can provide care to some of our patients.

Effective July 1, 2024, Maryland Medicaid will deny all pharmacy claims at the point-of-sale for prescriptions written by providers who are not enrolled with Maryland Medicaid. As a result, prescriptions issued by unenrolled practitioners will no longer be covered under your Medicaid plan.

Despite our unwavering commitment to serving all of our patients, these regulatory changes necessitate that we make some challenging decisions. Regrettably, as of July 1st., we will no longer be able to provide treatment or prescribe medications to patients under Maryland Medicaid, as our practitioners are not enrolled in the program.

We understand the potential impact this may have on your healthcare and sincerely regret any inconvenience this may cause. Ensuring that you receive uninterrupted care is of utmost importance to us, and we are committed to assisting you through this transition. To maintain continuity of care, we recommend seeking a practitioner enrolled with Maryland Medicaid to ensure that your prescriptions and treatments are covered.
